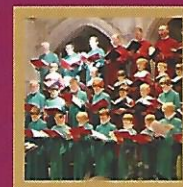

'Shadows of the Wanderer'

A powerful installation by the acclaimed sculptor, Ana Maria Pacheco. These powerful and dramatic sculptures present over life-size darkly robed figures as they witness the struggle of a young man to carry an older man on his shoulders. The group recalls the tale of Aeneas, who carries his father Anchises from the ruins of Troy, but this piece also speaks strongly of current issues, evoking the plight of refugees fleeing places of destruction in our own day.
